

## **2024 Summer Tax Millage Allocations**—the percentage of your tax dollars are used to pay:

City of Rockwood Common Fund (30%)—used to pay bills and maintain the infrastructure

Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP)—used to pay expenses and maintenance for our plant [1/2 of 1 percent]

Roads (2%)—used to pay for local street repairs and maintenance


State Education Fund (11%)—used to assist MI colleges with operating expenses

Gibraltar School Operating Fund (33%)—used to assist educating our children in the school district

Gibraltar School Debt Fund (13%)—used to pay for debt owed by the school district

Gibraltar Sinking Fund (1%)—savings used for capital projects and emergency repairs for the school district

Wayne County Operating Fund (10%)—used to pay operating expenses of Wayne County, like all municipalities





## **2025 Winter Tax Millage Allocations**—the percentage of your tax dollars are used to pay:

Wayne County Fund (7%)—used to pay for services to county residents

Wayne County Jail (7%)—funds used to maintain building housing incarcerated individuals

Wayne County Parks (2%)—funds used to maintain and provide recreation equipment for all citizens

Waste Water Treatment Plant Debt (WWTP) (9%)—used to pay City's bond payments to rebuild our sewage plant

Roads (7%)—funds used to pay for our local street repairs and upgrades

PA33 Fire/Ambulance (2%)—funds used to pay for our new ambulance

Huron-Clinton Metroparks (2%)—funds used to maintain recreation facilities

Wayne County Community College (23%)—funds used to pay bills and fund adult education

RESA\* Operating Fund (1%)—used to pay bills and provide educational opportunities for children and teacher training

RESA\* Special Education Fund (24%)—used to provide educational opportunities for disabled children

**RESA\* Enhancement (ENH) Fund (14%)**—used to supplement county school districts and public-school academies in addition to State funding [RESA is known as the county ISD. More information can be found on the information page.]

**Zoo Authority (1%)**—used to pay bills at the Detroit Zoo in caring for animals

Detroit Institute of Arts (DIA) Authority (1%)—funds used to maintain the Museum and exhibits

Rubbish is also included on your winter tax bill. It is not a millage, but it is your portion for services rendered during the year.
